Rehab and Respite Services

The Cape Health Center at Lake Prince Woods makes it easy for patients to plan their rehabilitation following illness, injury, elective surgery, or respite stay, using the EveryAge pre-registration program. Prospective patients are encouraged to visit the facility to meet the Team and to discuss with the Admissions Office, scheduled surgery, or respite dates. When The Cape Health Care Center is selected for short-term rehabilitation or respite services, the Admission Office provides a confirmed reservation for the patient.

STEP 1 Pre-registration: Patients begin their journey with a facility visit and are introduced to the Team, learn about therapy equipment and the care they will receive. The Admission Office is available to answer any insurance questions and will obtain any necessary insurance pre-authorization for services provided. For respite stays, the Admission Office will advise what items to bring and ask about the care needs of the resident.

STEP 2 Post-Registration: The Cape Health Care Center works closely with your physician to follow his/her protocols following your procedure. This means a patient receives consistent care regardless of care setting. While you are in the hospital, a member of facility Team helps to coordinate your transfer with the hospital case manager, visits to obtain additional information that is helpful to incorporate into your treatment plan. For respite stays, a member of the Team will reach out and re-confirm stay dates and gather information about the care needs of the resident.

STEP 3 Admission: At admission, patients are evaluated by nursing, therapy, social work and the physician or physician extender, to manage your care and collaborate on the treatment plan. The Team manages your care under the direction of a physician who continues to follow any post-hospital protocols. Respite stays include nursing care with physician access should your condition indicate it.

STEP 4 Preparing for Discharge: As a short-term option, The Cape Health Care Center focuses upon safe discharges to the community. The Team looks at other services the patient needs to be successful, such as out-patient, home care, home health services. These support services help a patient to continue progressing in their treatment plan. With respite discharges, the Team works with the family or caregiver to resume services in the community.
